## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD TRAINMEN UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Request that Dining Car Steward H. A. Fleming be carried on the dining car stewards seniority roster until he has attained the age of 65 years in order that he may enjoy the maximum benefits under the Retirement Act, and that he may return to service in the event he becomes physically qualified.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of September 17, 1954, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
