BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

ST. LOUIS SOUTHWESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- (1) That Carrier violated the rules of our current Agreement when it abolished the position of Storeroom Laborer, Illmo, Missouri, a Group 3 position, effective with close of business on December 4, 1953, and assigned the work normally attached to the Laborer's job to Group 1 clerical workers.
- (2) That Mr. R. R. Walker be reimbursed for loss suffered commencing with December 5, 1953, and continuing until the violation is corrected, due to the abolishment of position of Storeroom Laborer occupied by him.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 20, 1956, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
