**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood of Railway and Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employees that the Carrier violated the rules of the current agreement,

1. When on November 1, 1954 it required certain employees in the Minneapolis Mail Room to suspend work to absorb the meal period in violation of Rule 32(a) of the current agreement covering employees of our craft and class.

2. That the Carrier now be required to compensate the following employees for one hour overtime daily effective November 1, 1954, and each and every day thereafter until the violation is discontinued:

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of January 9, 1957, the parties jointly advised the Secretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.
