STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employees Local 351 on the property of the Chicago Eastern Illinois Railroad Company, that the position of Waiters-in-Charge be bulletined for assignment on Trains 17-18 and that successful bidder be compasted at applicable rate since August 12, 1955 for Carrier's violation of agreement in assigning service of food duties to Bartenders.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and
