STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the Agreement on December 3, 9 and 12, 1955 and on January 2, 5, 8, and 12, 1956 when it assigned or otherwise permitted employes excepted from the scope of the Agreement to supervise and direct laborers from Extra Gang No. MM-1 in performing work during overtime hours;
- (2) Foreman J. S. Hammonds, who was in charge of and had jurisdiction over Extra Gang No. MM-1, be allowed pay at the time and one-half rate of his position for the following number of hours:
