BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) Carrier violated the Agreement when it permitted an independent contractor to handle mail to and from the post office and station at Harpers Ferry, West Virginia, on various dates, and
- (2) That as a result of such violation Carrier now be required to compensate Baggage & Mail Porter J. L. McBee for one day's pay at the punitive rate on October 1, 1955 and similar claims of record on subsequent dates; and Baggage & Mail Porter D. L. McBee for one day's pay at the punitive rate on October 15, 1955 and similar claims of record on subsequent dates.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of January 30, 1957, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
