**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES**

GULF, COLORADO AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(a) Carrier violated the current Clerks' Agreement at Gainesville, Texas, when it denied to M. E. Liedtke the right to perform overtime work in Yard Office from 7:00 P. M. to 10:30 P. M., January 21, 1954, and from 6:00 P. M. to 8:00 P. M., January 22, 1954.

(b) M. E. Liedtke shall now be paid 3'30" at time and one-half at rate of Yard Clerk for January 21, 1954, and two (2) hours at time and one-half at rate of Yard Clerk for January 22, 1954.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of January 10, 1957, the parties addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
