### JOINT COUNCIL DINING CAR EMPLOYES

## CHICAGO, BURLINGTON AND QUINCY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employes, Local 848 on the property of Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad Company for and on behalf of Waiter-in-Charge B. F. Newton, that he be reinstated with compensation for net wages lost and seniority unbroken, account being unjusty and discriminatorily dismissed from Carrier's service on August 28, 1956.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of March 28, 1957, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
