#### PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

### THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

## THE NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD (Eastern District) (except Boston Division)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the New York Central Railroad (Buffalo and East), that:

- 1. Carrier violated agreement when on the 27th day of June 1955, it assessed against the record of J. A. Petell, discipline "Fifteen days record suspension."
- 2. Carrier violated agreement when on the 27th day of June 1955, it assessed against the record of R. C. Pacific, discipline "Fifteen days record suspension."
- 3. Carrier shall be required to clear the record of J. A. Petell and R. C. Pacific of discipline assessed as aforesaid.
- 4. Carrier shall be required to compensate R. C. Pacific in the sum of \$89.97 for time lost and reimbursement of expenses in connection with attendance at hearing, Watertown, N. Y., on June 24, 1955, and suspension from assignment.
- 5. Carrier shall be required to compensate J. A. Petell in the sum of \$54.50 for time lost and reimbursement of expenses in connection with attendance at hearing, Watertown, N. Y., on June 24, 1955.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of October 28, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

### AWARD

Claim dismissed.
