**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:**

**THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS**

**CENTRAL OF GEORGIA RAILWAY COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Central of Georgia Railway, that:

1. Carrier violated the agreement between the parties hereto when and because on March 18, 31; April 13, 14, 19, 20, 25, 27, 28; May 6 and 9, 1955, it directed Agent-Operator R. M. Yarbrough, at Porterdale, Ga., to leave train orders and clearance cards in the way-bill box for delivery to the crews of trains departing that station after Yarbrough had been released from duty; and

2. R. M. Yarbrough shall be paid for each of the dates mentioned in paragraph 1, an amount equivalent to a call (a minimum of two hours at the overtime rate), because he was not permitted to complete the handling by making delivery of the orders and clearance cards in question.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of November 24, 1958, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
