**THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS**  
**THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY**

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** *Claim of the Order of Railroad Telegraphers for all time and expense of the members we represent as a result of abolishing "DS" office, Terre Haute, and assigning work from this office to employees of other Departments.*

**FINDINGS:** *The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:*

*That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and*

*That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 13, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.*
