PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Order of Railroad Telegraphers that Extra Block Operator D. G. Squier be allowed deadheading rates under Regulation 4-L-1 and mileage rates for the use of his car under Regulation 8-M-1 when traveling to and from his home station, Avilla, Indiana, to various stations on the Fort Wayne Division, for the purpose of performing extra work and posting; same having been denied him in part, due to alleged change of headquarters from Avilla, Ind., to Grand Rapids effective July 15, 1953.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 13, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
