PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Pennsylvania Railroad Company that Block Operator W. D. Wells be allowed a Call, or an available extra operator, a day's pay account train orders 5, 6, and 7 being telephoned to train crews at Morrow, Ohio Block Office on February 12, 1952, during the hours this office was closed; also similar claims of other regular and extra block operators for various subsequent dates when train orders have been telephoned to this point during the hours that the office has been declared closed.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of August 13, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a forman communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
