STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of Joint Council Dining Car Employees Local 370 on the property of the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad Company, for and on behalf of Attendant E. Nevins for \$4.00 reimbursement, sleeping accommodations May 12, 13, 14 and 15, 1958, when employed in extra service Trains 77, 86 between New York and Springfield, Massachusetts.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 24, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.
