## THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

### UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY (Northwestern District)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Union Pacific Railroad (South Central and Northwestern Districts), that:

- 1. Carrier violated the agreement between the parties hereto when it failed and refused to properly compensate R. J. Simmons for services rendered on September 6, 1957, at Twin Falls, Idaho.
- 2. Carrier shall now be required to pay R. J. Simmons the sum of \$20.24 in addition to any amounts heretofore paid for services rendered at Twin Falls, Idaho, on September 6, 1957.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 4, 1959, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Claim dismissed.
