THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS MISSOURI ILLINOIS RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Missouri Illinois Railroad, that Carrier shall compensate E. J. Holcomb, an extra telegrapher, for 8 hours' pay at pro rata rate for work performed as telegrapher-cashier on June 23, 1957, at Salem, Illinois.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of December 31, 1959, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
