EROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES

CHICAGO, MILWAUKEE, ST. PAUL AND PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- 1. Carrier violated the Clerks' Rules Agreement when it failed to use the regular occupants of Positions No. 29, No. 44 and No. 33 at Council Bluffs, Iowa on February 22, 1954 to perform work that they normally would have performed on that day, had it not been a holiday, and in lieu thereof assigned that work to the occupants of other positions.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate Employes Robert Hastings, Richard W. Chapman and Floyd Parrack for eight (8) hours each at the penalty rate applicable to their respective positions.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That carrier and employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon has been held and concluded. Under date of January 4, 1960, the parties jointly advised the Sccretary of the Third Division of their desire to withdraw this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.
