# KANSAS, OKLAHOMA & GULF RAILWAY CO.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that the Carrier violated the Clerks' Agreement at Denison, Texas, from October 15, 1958 to October 29, 1958 inclusive, when,

- (a) It used Telegrapher Troy Smith to work vacation period of Yard Clerk Lewis Pipkin, and,
- (b) That furloughed Yard Clerk W. E. Bond shall now be compensated for 15 days at the regular rate of Yard Clerk account of this violation.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of April 6, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.

# AWARD

Case dismissed.
