ATLANTA JOINT TERMINALS

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

- (a) That the Carrier violated the Agreement when on June 15, 16 and 17, 1959, it required a Class 2 Porter to perform work belonging to Class 1 Clerks, failing to call the proper employe to perform the work.
- (b) Mr. R. H. Davis, Clerk shall now be additionally compensated in the amount of \$36.15 representing pay at proper rate for four and one-half hours June 15, four hours June 16, and two hours June 17, 1959.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employe involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of July 21, 1960, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.
