## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

### **BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES**

### KANSAS CITY TERMINAL RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement when it assigned repair work to the steel structure of the underpass at the south side of the Union Station to a contractor whose employes hold no seniority rights under the provisions of the controlling Agreement.
- (2) Messrs. C. H. Hopkins, M. S. Possen, L. O. Burdine, J. F. Harris, W. K. Long, A. A. Chisham and K. T. Bouyear each be allowed pay at their respective straight time rates for an equal proportionate share of the total number of man-hours consumed by the contractor's forces in performing the repair work referred to in Part (1) of this claim."

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of September 21, 1960, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

#### AWARD

Case dismissed.
