BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES

SOUTHERN PACIFIC LINES IN TEXAS AND LOUISIANA (Texas and New Orleans Railroad Company)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective agreement when it failed and refused to allow Bulldozer Operator Helper A. J. Sanders pay for each date October 6 to October 10, 1958, inclusive, and also failed and refused to allow expenses as claimed on expense account for the same dates.
- (2) Bulldozer Operator Helper A. J. Sanders be allowed eight (8) hours' pay for each date October 6 to October 10, 1958, inclusive.
- (3) Bulldozer Operator Helper A. J. Sanders be reimbursed for the expenses incurred and as reported on the expense account covering each of the above mentioned dates.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of November 14, 1960, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Case dismissed.
