BROTHERHOOD OF RAILROAD SIGNALMEN

CHICAGO AND NORTH WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the Chicago and North Western Railway Company that:

Mr. J. H. Bowden, Assistant Signal Maintainer, Central Seniority District, be paid the difference between \$2.164 and \$2.348 per hour for his service performed as Assistant Signal Maintainer from May 1, 1958, until corrected.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing was waived and under date of December 5, 1960, the parties jointly addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
