CHICAGO GREAT WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

**BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS,
FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYEES**

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: (23) Claim in behalf of Mr. O. E. Davison, Clerk, Bayfield, Minnesota, for Saturday, August 22, 1953 and Sunday, August 23, 1953 and all previous and subsequent Saturdays and Sundays for eight (8) hours at the rate of time and one-half of his position, account part-time employe being used to fill this position in alleged violation of Rule 33, paragraph (f) of the Clerks' Agreement—Carrier's file K-92, Organization's Case G-503.

OPINION OF BOARD: This case is the same as in Award 9867. For the reasons stated in that award, this claim should also be dismissed.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the claim is barred by Rule 40(d) of the Agreement.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
