## PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

## BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES LEHIGH VALLEY RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement when, in lieu of calling and using furloughed Track Laborer Iwan Pawluk to perform track laborer's work on January 26, 1959, it assigned or otherwise permitted Area Track Foreman Charles Martucci to perform said work.
- (2) Furloughed Track Laborer Iwan Pawluk now be allowed eight hours' straight time pay because of the violation referred to in Part (1) of this claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex parte by complainant party; and

That no hearing thereon has been held, and under date of July 5, 1961, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.

## AWARD

Case dismissed.
