PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

MR ARTHUR E. DASE

THE CHESAPEAKE AND OHIO RAILWAY COMPANY (Chesapeake District)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: That my original seniority date of November 17, 1941 in Group 1 be restored and my seniority date of August 6, 1941 in Group 2 be restored for the purpose of selecting vacation periods.

OPINION OF BOARD: The record is clear that the claim the Peti-tioner is attempting to assert before the Board has not been handled in accordance with the requirements of Section 3, First (i) of the Railway Labor Act, Circular No. 1 of the National Railroad Adjustment Board and Rule 27 1/2 of the applicable Agreement. The claim, is, therefore, barred and will be dismissed.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are re-spectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act. as approved June 21, 1984:

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the claim is barred.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
