(Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Company

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Company that:

Carrier pay to Signal Maintainer R. E. Hickerson additional time equal to 1-6/12 hours' overtime for service he performed on May 6, 1972, Claimant's regular off-day, assisting in locating signal trouble which occurred on A territory not assigned to Hickerson.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and Employee involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board a parte by the complainant party; and

That hearing thereon was waived by the parties and under date of March 5, 1974, the complainant party addressed a formal communication to the Secretary of the Third Division requesting withdrawal of this case, which request is hereby granted.
