STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of

Railroad Signalmen on the Central of Georgia Railway

Company that:

Carrier pay to its signal employes whose assignments to positions in the Signal Crew, Signal Inspector, Signal Maintainer at Savannah, Ga., and Signalman at Macon, Ga., are concurrent with the progressing of the above-referred-to work by the contractor's forces, time equal to the number of man-hours of work performed by said contractor's forces or persons not covered by Agreement with the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen.

Claimants presently in the Signal Crew include Foreman B. F. Jones; Leading Signalman L. B. Hardison, Signalmen J. W. Mayberry, J. D. Grissett, Ronnie King, and Billy MacMorriss; Assistant Signalmen Mike McClellan and D. W. Baker. J. B. Dumas is presently Signal Inspector. E. E. Murdock is presently Signal Maintainer at Savannah, Ga., and R. J. Stewart is presently Signalman at Macon, Ga.

Claim commencing on May 26, 1970, and continuing thereafter until the project is completed or the proper correction is made.

The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the carrier and employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this **Division** of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute **involved** herein;

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board ex partebythe complainant party; and
