STATEMENT OF **CLAIM**: Whether the company violated the current Signalmen's Agreement when it permitted **Commonwealth** Edison **Company** to lay an inductively shielded underground cable on company property **near** Ksnkakee, Illinois, in connection with its furnishing electrical service to nearby **communities**.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board **ex parte** by the complainant party; and
