PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Whether the company violated the current Signalmen's Agreement when it permitted **Commonwealth Edison Company** to lay an inductively shielded underground cable on company property **near** Ksnkakee, Illinois, in connection with its furnishing electrical service to nearby **communities**.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board finds:

That the dispute was certified to the Third Division of the Adjustment Board **ex parte** by the complainant party; and

That under date of November 27, 1974 the **complainant** party addressed a **formal** communication to the **Executive** Secretary of the Third Division, **concurrent** in by the Respondent, requesting withdrawal of this case from further consideration by the Division, which request is hereby granted.
