(Chicago, Milwaukee, St. **Paul** and Pacific Railroad Company

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-7493) that:

- 1. Carrier violated the provisions of the Clerks' Rules Agreement at Chicago, Illinois when it refused to pay employe M. Stout for time absent account sickness occurring April 24 through 28, 1972 inclusive;
- 2. Carrier shall now be required to compensate **employe** M. Stout for four days' pay at the rate applicable to Position No. 2880, **Comptometer** Operator, in line with the provisions of Memorandum No. 2 for April 24 through 28, 1972.

OPINION OF BOARD: The record indicates that Carrier's failure to allow sick leave payment to **Employe** Stout for April 24 through April 28, 1972 violated the provision of revised Memorandum of **Agreement** No. 2. In addition, Carrier's refusal to honor statements from her physician violated the provisions of paragraph (H) thereof. Therefore we will sustain the **claim**.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
