PARTIES TO DISPUTE: (

(Chicago and North Western Transportation Company

- (a) The Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement wher on the close of the work day, September 12, 1972, the signal maintainers' positions ware abolished and in each instance a new position of Leader Si_{ξ} Mtnr. was established.
- (b) The Carrier should now be required to x-establish the position as separate signal maintainer position as they were previous to September 12, 1972. (Carrier's file: 79-8-97)

OPINION OF BOARD: Award 20630 involves these **same** parties and agreement as well as an interpretation and application of Rule 20(a). Following that award and the doctrine which precludes **consideration** of moot questions or abstract propositions or the affirmation of **principlo** which do not affect the matter in **issue, we** must deny the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole reco: and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the **Adjustment** Board has jurisdiction **ove**: the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was not violated.
