PARTIES TO DISPUTE: [Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen
(Chicago and North Western Transportation Company)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood
of Railroad Signalmen on the Chicago and North
Western Transportation Company:

(a) On May 20, 1973 the Carrier violated the current Signal-
man's Agreement particular **rule** 16(a) when it failed to call Mr. K. Hodge
assigned **Ldr.** Sig. Mtnr. at Lake Bluff, Ill. for signal trouble at Dunes
Park.

(b) Carrier now be required to compensate Mr. Hodge for **2 1/2**
hours and **40** minutes (a call) for the above violation. Carrier's File:
79-8-139]

OPINION OF BOARD: The employees have failed to support their burden
of proof in this case. We find no violation of
the Agreement. Therefore, we will deny the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole
record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the **Carrier** and the Employees involved in this dispute are
respectively **Carrier** and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor
Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

'That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction
over the dispute involved **herein**; and

That the Agreement was not violated.

A W A R D
