PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company

**<u>STATEMENT OF CLAIM</u>**: Claim of the System **Committee** of the Brotherhood (GL-7758) that:

(1) Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties November 4, 1973, when it permitted or required train service employees to perform duties which for many years by custom, practice and tradition have been **performed** by agency forces at Sanford, North Carolina.

(2) Carrier shall be required to compensate Agent W. P. Cox one call three (3) hours at **time** and one-half the pro rata rate November 4, 1973, for the violation aforesaid.

<u>OPINION OF BOARD</u>: The facts and circumstances presented **in** this claim are similar in **all** material respects to those found in Award **20938** and it **must** be denied for the reasons expressed in that

Award.

<u>FINDINGS</u>:, The **Third** Division of the Adjustment Hoard, upon the whole record **and all** the evidence, finds and holds:

That the **parties** waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier **and the Employes involved in this** dispute are respectively Carrier **and** Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June **21**, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Carrier did not **violate** the Agreement.

<u>AWARD</u>.

Claim denied.
