**PARTIES TO DISPUTE:** (Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen  
(Missouri Pacific Railroad Company

**STATEMENT OF CUM:** Claim of the **General Committee** of the **Brotherhood**  
of Railroad **Signalmen** on the **Missouri pacific**  
Railroad Company:

On behalf of Signal For- C. L. Kemp, **Signalman** J. L. c&k  
and **Assistant K. L. Blagrove, Gang 1412, Houston, Texas**, for an addi-  
tional payment of four (4) hours each at time and one-half their respec-  
tive straight time hourly rate; **account work of their assignments was**  
denied them when the Carrier **assigned employes of another Craft**  
(**Electricians**) to **construct and install** a meter loop, a part of a high-  
way flasher **installation**, at **Park Street, Baytown, Texas**, on September 11,  
1973, in violation of the Scope Rule of the **Signalmen's Agreement**.

**OPINION OF BOARD:** This dispute **concerns assignment** to other than  
signal **employes to construct and install** a meter  
loop as part of a **highway flasher installation**, and an **asserted violation**  
of the **Scope Rule**.

Our review of the **record indicates to us** that the **same basic**  
**issues were raised and disposed of by our recent Awards 20532 and 20708**  
**concerning these same parties**. We have **considered the Organization's**  
**response to Award 20532 as contained in its Rebuttal Statement**, but we  
**find no basis for disturbing our prior Awards**.

**For reasons stated in Awards 20532 and 20708 we will dismiss**  
**this claim**.

**FINDINGS:** The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole  
record and all the evidence, **finds and holds:**

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes involved in this dispute are**  
**respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor**  
**Act, as approved June 21, 1934;**

**That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction**  
**over the dispute involved herein; and**

That the Claim be **dismissed**.
