STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-7697)that:

1. Carrier violated the Clerks' Rules Agreement at Milwaukee, Wisconsin when it failed to afford employe L. Bintz a fair and impartial investigation.

2. Carrier further violated the agreement when it suspended employe L. Bintz from Carrier service for 6 period of thirty (30) days, which we6 arbitrary and unjust.

3. Carrier shall now be required to clear employe L. Bintz's record of the charges made and pey him for all time lost.

OPINION OF BOARD: The **record** indicate6 **that** the **claimant** was given 6 fair and impartial hearing.

Nothing in the record indicate6 the Carrier he6 acted in an arbitrary or capricious manner, noris there any evidence of bad faith on the pert of the Carrier toward this employe.

The precedent is well established that this Board should not substitute it6 judgment forthat of the Carrier in discipline cases where it ha6 produced substantial evidence that the offense was committed. Accordingly, weshall not disturb Carrier'6 action.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, find6 and holds:

That the parties waived orel hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute cue respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, 66 approved June 21, 1934; Award Number 21094 Docket Number CL-20991

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

Thbt the Agreement was not violated.

AWARD

Claim denied.
