Claim No. 1:

S-85 (A) The Carrier violated **and** continues to violate the currant **Signal**men's Agreement bearing effective date of **June** 1, 1951, particularly rules two (2) end three (3) **working** en Asst. Signal Maintainer under the direct supervision of **a** Leading Signal Maintainer.

(b) Carrier **now** be required to **pay** the signal maintainer **rate** of **pay** to the Asst. Signal **Maintainer** who **was** used to work directly with end under the supervision of the **Leading Signal Maintainer at** Butler, **Wis.**, starting 60 days prior to the deta of thia claim **and** until **thir** violation **is** corrected.

Claim No. 2;

S-86 (A) **The** Carrier violated end continues to violate the current **Signal**man's **Agreement** bearing **effective date** of June 1, 1951, **particular** rules two (2) end three (3) by **working** en **Asst. Signal** Maintainer under the direct **supervision** of a Leading Signal Maintainer.

(b) Carrier now be required to peythe signal maintainer rate of pay to the Asst. Signal Maintainer who wee used to work directly with and under the supervision of the Leading Signet Maintainer et St. Francis, Wis. starting 60 days prior to the date of this claim end until this violation is corrected.

Claim No. 3:

S-87 (A) The carrier violated end continues to violate the currant **Signal**man's **Agreement** bearing effective date of June 1, 1951, particular rules **two** (2) end three (3) by working an **Asst. Signal** Maintainer under the direct supervision of **a** Leading **Signal** Maintainer.

(b) Carrier **now** be required to pey the signal maintainer rate of **pay** to the Asst. Signal Maintainer **who was** used to **work** directly with end under the supervision of the **Leading Signal** Maintainer et **Racine**, Wisconsin, starting 60 days prior to the date of this claim end until this violation is corrected.

<u>OPINION OF BOARD</u>: This dispute presents claims to the Board which are the same, in concept, es the one presented in Award

21097.
