STATRMRNT OF CLAIM: Claim of the General **Committee** of the Brotherhood of **Rail-** road Signalmen on the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company:

(a) Carrier violated the current Signalmen's Agreement, as amended, particularly the Scope, **seniority**, promotions, hours of service, bulletining and **assignment** rules, historical and traditional practice,. **when** it arranged or **otherwise** permitted the General Railway Signal Company to assemble two **Type** El-60 Retarders.

(b) Carrier should **now** be required to compensate all employee listed below at their pm-rata rate: •

OPINION OF **BOARD**: The **Employes** asserted a Scope Rule violation when Carrier obtained a pre-assembled retarder.

This dispute does not deal with work performed on the property. Rather, it deals with an item made at a factory. Such off-property work is not contemplated by the Agreement. See, for example, Award 20926.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employee involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That the Agreement was not violated.
