PARTIES TO DISPUTE: (

(Chicago and North Western Transportation Company

Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that: STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- (1) The dismissal of Machine Operator M. **Kensicki** for alleged "violation of Rule 'G'", was arbitrary, without just and sufficient cause and on the basis of unproven charge8 (System File D-11-1-303).
- (2) The claimant shall now be accorded the benefits prescribed in Agreement Rule 19(d).

Claimant was afforded due process. OPINION OF BOARD:

The record contains substantial evidence of probative value that Claimant was quilty of violation of Rule G.

The discipline imposed by Carrier -- dismissed from service -was mt excessive.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, find8 and holds:

That the parties waived **oral** hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was mt violated.

AWARD

Claim denied.
