PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(National Railroad Passenger Corporation

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The discipline of Maintenance Helper J. **DiNoto** for alleged violation of Rules I and Y of the National Railroad Passenger' Corporation General Rules was without just or sufficient cause and **on** the basis of unproven charges.
- (2) The claimant's personal record shall be cleared of said charges and he shall be reimbursed for all wage loss suffered as a consequence of said discipline."

OPINION OF BOARD: Claimant was suspended from the service of the Carrier for 60 days after having been found guilty of violating Rules I and Y of the National Railroad Passenger Corporation General Rules.

We have reviewed the transcript of the hearing and **find** that there **was** sufficient evidence presented to support the finding of guilt, We will deny the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of **the** Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as apprwed June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction **over** the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was not violated.
