**STATEMENT OF CLAIM:** "Claim of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the Burlington Northern:

On behalf of Mr. W. R. Moore, **Signalman**, in Signal Crew **#131**, for reimbursement of five days compensation, when Carrier violated, Rule 54-C of the current Signalmen's Agreement and **also**, assessed him **harsh** and unfair discipline of five days actual suspension." /General Chairman's file C-77-115. Carrier's file SI-20 5/10/77 A\_/

OPINION OF BOARD: Claimant, another Signalman, and an Assistant Signalman were assigned to change out wires between the signal head and a **junction box.** After completing the work they failed to make tests **which** are required by the rules.

**Claimant and** the other **Signalman were both** found to be at fault. **Claimant was** given **five days** actual suspension. The other **Signalman was given only a reprimend.** Carrier based its disparate treatment-on **the fact that Claimant was** the senior **employe** end was in charge.

The record shows that the **supervisor** bad not placed Claimant in charge of the work. At the investigation claimant said he was senior and "supposed" he was in charge. Notwithstanding what Claimant "supposed" there is no basis in the record for finding that Claimant was in a leading position. He and the other signalman were equally responsible for the improperly done work and should have received equal discipline. There were no circumstances, other than Claimant's seniority, to base a different measure of discipline upon.
