PARTIES TO DISPUTE: ((Illinois Central Gulf Railroad

<u>STATEMENT OF CLAIM</u>: "Claim of the General **Committee** of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the **Illinois Central Gulf** Railroad:

On behalf of Signalman J. W. Pickle, employee number 677192, hire date 9-22-69, account his position as Signal Maintainer, Sparta, Illinois, being abolished April 7, 1978 (claim presented to Manager of Labor Relations under date of June 5, 1978)." (Carrier file: 135-377-196 Spl)

<u>OPINIONOF BOARD</u>: This is a claim for benefits under the National Mediation **Agreement** of November 16, 1971 (Article VIII) or the **IC-GMO** Merger Protection Agreement of **May** 18, 1972 (Appendix G) which benefits accrue when an **employe** is required to change his point of employment in excess of thirty miles.

Before either agreement provision can be invoked the **claimant** must show that he was "required" to move. Such was not the case in the instant matter. The claimant had the right to displace **employes** junior to him on gangs that had headquarters within claimant's prior residence and work location. Absent a **finding** that **claimant** was required to **move** the other issues raised in this matter are moot.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, **upon the** whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has **jurisdiction** over the dispute involved herein; and
