(Brotherhood of Railway, Airline and (Steamship Clerks, Freight Handlers, Express and Station Employes

PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

The Western Pacific Railroad Company

**Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-8661) that:

- 1. The Western **Pacific** Railroad Company violated the current Clerks' Agreement when on June 1, **1977**, and those subsequent days upon which they instructed Mechanical Department **employes** not cowered under the Agreement to perform work belonging to the Sacramento Store Department Clerks.
- 2. Clerk W. J. **Funk** whose position was subsequently abolished because of the elimination of this work on June **3, 1977**, shall be allowed eight hours at time and one-half for the violation of the Current Agreement on all dates upon which the violation occurs and also have his position re-established. (All dates on **which** the violations have occurred **are** being mutually kept by both Carrier and **Employes** through **claims** of a **like** nature.)"

OPINIONOFBOARD: The issue in dispute in this case seems to us to be squarely on point with that in Award No. 1, Public Law Board 2172, Dana E. Elschen, chairman, involving the same parties. That award denied the claim of the Organization. We do not find Award 1 to be in error. The present claim will be denied.

<u>FINDINGS</u>: The **Third** Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employee Involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board $\verb|bas|$ jurisdiction over the dispute $\verb|involved|$ herein; and

That the Agreement was not violated.

AWARD

Claim denied.
