PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(Illinois Central Gulf Railroad

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: 'This is to serve notice, as required by the rules of the National Railroad Adjustment Board, of my intention to file an ex parte submission on April 28, 1980 covering an unadjusted dispute between me and the Illnois (sic) Central Gulf Railroad involving the question:

My dismissal on November 23, 1979 for alleged violation of **Rule 10(A)** and **Rule** 38, in accordance with the Schedule of **Rules** and Working Conditions **govering** (sic) the Maintenance of Way and Structures Department dated April 27, 1978."

OPINION OF BOARD: The record before the Board is clear that the claim that the claimant is attempting to assert before the Board has not been handled on the property in accordance with the requirements of Section 3, First (i) of the Railway Labor Act. Under such conditions, the Board has no alternative but to dismiss the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway labor Act, as apprwed June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has **jurisdiction** over the dispute involved herein; and

That the claim be dismissed.

A W A R D

Claim dismissed.
