Claim on behalf of A. **L. Swicegood** for meal expense above the **\$9.001imit carrier** placed on daily meal allowance."

OPINION OF BOARD: In a companion case Award No. 23274, involving the same parties and the same issue, we found Third Division Award 23190dispositive of the claim. Based upon the evidence of record before us, we find the aforesaid Award controlling herein and thus we are compelled to deny the Instant claim.

FINDINCS: The Third **Division** of the **Adjustment** Board, after giving the parties to this dispute due notice of hearing thereon, and upon the **whole** record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in **this** dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, **1934**;

That this Division of the Adjustment **Board** has **jurisdiction** over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement wasnotviolated.

AWARD

Claim denied.
