STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-8861) that:

1. Carrier violated the effective Clerks 'Agreement when, following an investigation on August 18,1978, it suspended Clerk L. A. Clark fromservice for a period of five days without just cause;

2. Carrier shall now compensate Clerk L. A.Clark for all time lost as a result of this suspension from service and shall clear his record of the charge placed against him.

<u>OPINION OF BOARD</u>: **Claimant** was **suspended from** the service of the Carrier for five days after **having been** found to have absented himself from duty without permission or **proper** authority **on** August **9** and 10 of **1978**.

It is the position of the Organization that the **Claiment** properly reportedoff and that the Carrier has failed to prove the charge.

While there does appear to be some conflict in the evidence presented at the investigation, a review of the transcript of the hearing reveals that substantive evidence of probative value was produced at the hearing to support the charge and the finding of the hearing officer. It is not our position to weigh the evidence in the instant matter and substitute our opinion for that of the hearing officer. We are unable to conclude that the finding of the Carrier officer was arbitrary and capricious and without foundation and accordingly, we will deny the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934; Award Number 23394 Docket Number CL-23000 Page 2

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreementwas not violated.

AWARD

Claim denied.
