STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claims of the General Committee of the Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen on the Southern Railway Company, et al.:

Claim No. 1

On behalf of System Gang Signalman J. E. Petree for meal expense he incurred over the arbitrary \$9.00 per day limit imposed by the Carrier, beginning with the expense period ending January 15, 1979, and continuing so long as Carrier refuses to reimburse his actual necessary meal expense.

Claim No. 2

General Chairman file: SR-114 Carrier file: SG-390

On behalf of System Gang Signalman R. W. Walley for meal expense he incurred over the arbitrary \$9.00 per day limit imposed by the Carrier, beginning with the expense period ending January 15, 1979, and continuing so long as Carrier refuses to reimburse his actual necessary meal expense."

OPINION OF BOARD: This case presents a dispute which is similar to the one presented to us in Docket SG-22861. We have compared this record to the record presented in the mentioned case, and we conclude that Award 2390 controls.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employees involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;
