PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

(consolidated Fail Corporation

**STATEMENT** OF **CLAIM**: "This is to serve notice, as required by the rules of the National Railroad Adjustment **Board**, of my intention to file an **ex parte submission** on March 20, **1980** covering an unadjusted **dis**pute between me and **CONRAIL** involving the question:

That Mr. W. Maliff (Supervisor C&S) erred in awarding the position advertised by Bulletin M 45 - 78, to Mr.J. Heaphy, and not to me, Harold G. Karr

OPINION OF BOARD: The Carrier has pointed out that the Claimant failed to comply with certain time limits, as specified in the

Agreement.

We note specifically that the **Employe** did not present the dispute to this **Board** within the 9 month period mandated in the pertinent Agreement. Accordingly, regardless of the other contentions advocated by the parties, we find that we are without authority to consider the matter, **and** we **will** dismiss the claim.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the **Adjustment** Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the **Employes** involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and **Employes** within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the claim is barred.
