PARTIES TO DISPUTE: (

(Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Company

STATEMENT OF CIAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9024) that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the **provisions** of the General Agreement and **Memorandum** Agreement dated September 1, 1949 and arrange to **allow M. N. Perdue 3**day:; in excess of 252 Annual Work Days in 1974.
- (b) **The** Carrier should now recompute M. N. **Perdue's** pay for the Year **1974** and allow him **\$112.92** for 2 days pay due to working 3 days in excess of the **252**Annual. Work Days in **1974**.

OPINION OF BOARD: Except as to name of Claiment, the Claimant's rate of pay, and a claim for two days' pay instead of one day's pay, this claim is identical to that considered by the Board in Award No. 23589. Upon full review of the record, an identical award is appropriate, based upon all the same reasoning.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway **Labor** Act, as approved June 21, **1934**;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
