STATEMENT OF **CLAIM:** Claim of the System **Committee** of the Brotherhood (GL-9026) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not **apply** the provisions of the General Agreement and Memorandum **Agreement** dated **September** 1, **1949** and arrange to allow J. J. **Longo 4** days **in** excess of 252 **Annual** Work **Days** in **1974.**

(b) The Carrier should now recompute J. J. Longo's pay for the Year 1974 and allow him \$112.92 for 2 days pay due to working 4 days in excess of the 292 Annual Work Days in 1974.

OPINION OF BOARD: Except as to name of Claimant, the Claimant's rate of pay, and a claim for two days' pay instead of one day's pay, this claim is identical to that considered by the Board in Award No. 23589. Upon full review of 'the record, an identical award is appropriate, based upon all the same reasoning.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties waived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
