<u>STATEMEN</u> Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood (GL-9027) that:

(a) The Carrier violated the Clerical Agreement when they did not apply the provisions of the General Agreement and **Memorandum** Agreement dated September 1, **1949** and **arrange** to **allow**, **Mary** Jean **Lockamy ID #2802105,2** days in excess of 251Annwl Work Days in **1976**.

(b) The Carrier should now recompute M. J. Lockamy pay for the year **1976** and **allow** here \$120.66, for 2 days pay due to working 2 days in excess of the **251 Annual Work** Days in **1976**.

OPINION OF BOARD: Except as to name of Claimant, the change in **number** of holidays, the Claimant's rate of pay, and a claim for two days' pay instead of one day's pay, this claim **is** identical to that considered by the Board in Award **No. 23589. Upon full review** of the record, an **identical** award is appropriate, based upon all the **same** reasoning.

FINDINGS: The Third Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and **all** the evidence, finds and holds:

That the parties wived oral hearing;

That the Carrier and the Employes involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, **as** approved June 21, 1934;

That this Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein; and

That the Agreement was violated.
